

ASSISTIVE DEVICES PROGRAM FUNDING

Who can apply?

Any permanent resident of Ontario with a valid health card and a long-term physical disability requiring an aid (brace or prosthetic limb) for six months or longer can apply.

What do I do first?

Consult with an approved ADP authorizer/provider, such as Niagara Prosthetics & Orthotics Corp., to complete the appropriate application form.

How much does ADP contribute?

ADP will pay 75% of the approved price. You or your supplementary health insurance will be charged for the remaining 25%, as well as any additional components or procedures not covered by ADP. In some cases other government or charitable funding may be available. If you receive social assistance benefits from OW, ODSP or ACSD, ADP may pay up to 100% of the approved price.
